### **ELECTRICAL APPRENTICE**

The Commercial Electrical apprentice should have the ability and aptitude to master the skills of the electrical trade. This requires the ability to work as well and attend classes at ACEF a minimum of (1) night week. Apprentice levels are as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup> Year .....	0 to 2000 OJT Hours .....	& .....	0 to 160 Classroom Hours
2 <sup>nd</sup> Year .....	2001 to 4000 OJT Hours .....	& .....	161 to 320 Classroom Hours
3 <sup>rd</sup> Year .....	4001 to 6000 OJT Hours .....	& .....	321 to 480 Classroom Hours
4 <sup>th</sup> Year .....	6001 to 8000 OJT Hours .....	& .....	481 to 640 Classroom Hours

#### **Basic Responsibilities and Requirements:**

1. High School Diploma or GED
2. Valid Driver's License and dependable transportation to and from jobsite
3. Ability to attend class at ACEF minimum of (1) night per week
4. Pass a pre-employment substance testing
5. Read blue prints and ability to grasp instructions readily (levels 2 thru 4)
6. Pass a pre-employment safety class

#### **Physical Requirements:**

1. On your Feet or standing up to 8 hours per day
2. Walking up to 8 hours per day, 1-2 miles per day
3. Pushing and pulling up to 8 hours per day, 100-150lbs torque
4. Climbing up and down 8 hours per day
5. Bending, Kneeling or Squatting up to 8 hours per day
6. Heavy Lifting up to 100 lbs maximum or 50 lbs frequently

#### **Following items a definite plus:**

1. Prior experience in construction; adaptation to learning; ability to use constructive guidance; ability to lead and follow instruction; be safety oriented and have mechanical ability.

Benefits include paid time off, paid holidays, health, dental, vision, retirement, and AFLAC policies. 90-day probationary period required before benefits are recognized.

\* Upon hire, all current Electrical Apprentices will be required to provide copy of current EA license, OJT Hours and Classroom hours for final wage determination..
